Tamar Ridge Botrytis Riesling 2011, Tasmania, Australia (37.5cl) £25.00

The Tamar Ridge crew only produce this amazing wine when extreme
weather conditions permit it, it is so good I often wonder if the locals rather
perversely and privately prey for a drought! The wine is a luscious dessert style
with abundant honeydew, marmalade and citrus flavours.

A finer style of dessert wine than the vast majority with honey and toffee apple flavours,
layers of complexity filling the mouth. Bright natural acidity balances the sweetness leaving a
fresh long finish.
